National Standards results from 2016 There is still much debate about the use of National Standards at school, and the value they give students, parents or teachers. As a state school we are expected to report on reading, writing and maths standards, which indicate where a child is compared with the expected standard, across NZ. As of the end of last year, 83% of our students were reading at or above the relevant standard, 76% were writing at or above the relevant standard and 82 % were at or above the relevant standard in maths. These are positive results, but even more positive is that we have evidence that 100% of our students showed progress last year. ③

BUS news The aim for everyone is always to have a safe and happy bus ride. All bus monitors have had meetings and training with Police Education Officer Gerry Tonkin this morning. We have reviewed the bus rules and expectations of bus monitors. Parents, please talk with your child about bus behaviour. We do not expect loud, attention seeking and inappropriate language or behaviour on the bus. Should anything unacceptable come to Ms Turner's notice, there will be consequences - this may include dialogue with parents.

Care of the School Grounds and Swimming Pool over the holidays Thank you to everybody who used the school facilities with such respect during the holidays. It is great to see families here playing tennis, riding bikes or enjoying the grounds. School is a community facility and it is great that our families get to use it. Of course this also helps to keep an eye on things during the break! Thanks also for supporting our school pool this season. It costs the school thousands of dollars to maintain every year, not to mention the time and care required to ensure it is safe for our children to swim in. Special thanks to Ian and Vanessa who did such a great job over the holidays and to all of you who have made donations and purchased pool keys. We are lucky to have this facility and hope we are able to maintain it for many more years to come.
