EMERGENCY PROCEDURES Thank you for responding so positively to last week's "test text" that we sent out to all parents. We had an awesome 98% response rate. If you live in an area where there is no cell phone reception, in the event of an emergency we would contact you via landline and also by email.

Keeping your children safe at school is one of our priorities! The car park is an area that staff has identified as a place of potential risk. Because of this, we ask that children wait inside the school grounds near the little gate, and that parents come on to the grounds to collect their children. The tricky part can be when parents catch up with other parents, in the car park area. Of course this is fine, but we expect that children will be in your car and not playing around the area! Even if you are able to supervise your child, others see through the fence and may want to play too! It could just take one small child to run through the car park area and not be seen by a car backing out, for an accident to happen.

It is great that we have had so many parents and their children coming in to talk with teachers about learning goals over the past weeks.
