Netball Fundraiser this Friday 23 November Room 5 students will be selling \$2 bags of lollies to raise money for our netball teams again this Friday.

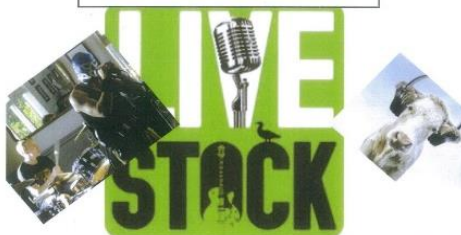
