Seeds for Sale

This year we have bought some seed in bulk from Kings seeds and have surplus to sell. It is all new season seed and will be able to be collected by the beginning of September.

We have available at \$2 a packet: Sweet pea - Old Spice Antiques (approx 20 seeds) Corn - Honey & Pearl (approx 20 seeds) - Treated Seed Pea - Petite Provincial (approx 40 seeds) Bean - Dwarf - Royality Blue (approx 20 seeds) Organic Seed Bean - Dwarf - French Garden Filet (approx 20 seeds) Organic Seed Sunflower - mix - (approx 20 Seeds) - Treated Seed Available at \$4 market

Zucchini - Black Coral (5 seeds)

Watermelon - Sweet Red F1 (5 Seeds)

<u>Tomato Seedlings</u> We will also have some surplus punnets of small tomato seedlings available in a few weeks, keep an eye on the newsletter for more info.

<u>Growers needed</u> This year we plan to repeat what we did last year and use the school tunnel house for the plants that have longer growing times & really need heat. We would like to grow some of the other faster varieties at school families' homes. We are looking for up to 8 families to grow 1 (or more) lines each at home. The school will supply seed, potting mix, pots, trays & dates for planting. Space required to grow at

home is 1 bread trays worth (per variety). Depending on your confidence level the seeds can be planted before you take the trays home. If you have a warm/bright & safe (free of pets/toddlers and pests) space and you think you can help please get in touch. Seed planting will start around early September so you will be required to look after them for 4-8 weeks depending on the variety you grow.
