# HEAD LICE ALERT

PLEASE CHECK YOUR CHILD'S HAIR TONIGHT!!

Check the scalp for insects or eggs. Use a fine-tooth comb on wet hair then comb through the hair in sections looking for eggs or lice, repeat over a few days.

Treating head lice does not have to be expensive. Brushing hair thoroughly and regularly damages nits and eggs. Cheap conditioner or vegetable oil works too. Check every day and treat at least every seven days to break the cycle. Check your child's hair tonight!

Always re-treat 7–10 days after the first treatment, to kill any head lice that may have hatched from eggs that survived the first treatment

✓ Check and treat the hair every night Please tie up long hair for school ✓ If your child has head lice please check everyone in the family home ✓ Do not share hairbrushes, towels, hats/ scarves etc.



# Have you heard of the GoodSAM App?



GoodSAM

The GoodSAM app is a free app that alerts people that a patient suspected to be in cardiac arrest is nearby, allowing them to possibly save a life by providing CPR and using an AED

(if available) prior to emergency services arriving.

Our nearest AED is located at the Ngatimoti Community Rooms adjacent to our School. Particularly if you have a first-aid qualification this may be of interest to you.
