<u>Enviro Leaders' Trip this Friday</u>: Our school is very proud to be seeking opportunities for students to be in, learn about, and care for the environment. This Friday our Enviro Leaders will go to Bark Bay on a learning journey. The planned activities include

- Some history including some stories about Medlands, learning about a Te Atiawa pou thinking about the changes at the sandspit and finding out about the Huffam family
- Some biology what food sources are at Bark Bay for the birds, how are the kaka and other birds surviving and what different fungi can be found.
- Some maths, as one of the prime objectives of this trip is to do another marine litter survey. This data is sorted and analysed in an ongoing study.

These topics all develop our young scientists with skills of observation, patience, and abilities to predict, question and use technical equipment. They learn with and from others, and learn that even though they are young, their ideas are valued and their leadership is appreciated. Many thanks to Heather Reid for offering to lead this day.



Y3/4 - Festival day starts at 8.30am for one hour of fun games.


Y5/6 - please arrive at 9.10am for your 9.40am game.
