That is worth celebrating!

A symbol for celebrating a 21st is a key, and this can represent knowledge and success. Since keys can open doors which are closed to anyone other than the key holder, thinking of a key as a symbol of environmental awareness could mean our students have opened their minds to problem solving and a world of possibilities. At Ngatimoti School, being an enviro-school has meant that all of our learners have had opportunities to enjoy being in the natural environment, they have learned about environmental issues, and they have had many opportunities to connect with others. Over the years, we have learned about birds, plants, food, fish, harakeke, water, rocks, waste, grayling, eels, the stream, butterflies, weeds, gardens, pests, local places, the sea, animals and the river. We have had numerous trips, worked on some challenges and met many great people. Students have shared their learning, hosted others, and connected with other students, scientists, neighbours and organisations. Being an enviro-school has meant that we have many great memories of our time at Ngatimoti School.

To add to these memories, we plan some celebrations next week. On Tuesday the Enviro-Leaders have a trip to Flora Hut in the Kahurangi National Park planned. On Wednesday we have a special enviro-assembly at 12 midday, followed by a shared lunch. We ask that all families bring some food to share that reflects our enviro awareness. E.g. locally grown food, food that has little or no wrapping, raw food or seasonal food. You are all welcome to come along to join us too!




